PRESS RELEASE #23 - Shelter Listing Issued on: Saturday August 30, 2008 at 8:00 p.m.

As a consequence of the devastation caused by Tropical Storm Gustav, reports from the Parish Disaster Offices to the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Management (ODPEM) have revealed that there are currently 88 shelters opened, housing a total of 1123 person islandwide. The shelters being occupied are detailed below.
